QUALIFICATIONS: Master's Degree in a helping profession and a Licensed Addictions Counselor (LAC) or an Addiction Counselor in Training (ACT) working toward an LAC. Must have a current driver's license, car insurance and a driving record acceptable to Southeastern's insurance provider. Must pass a comprehensive criminal background check, including fingerprinting, drug screening.

JOB SUMMARY: The CD Therapist will be a member of a multidisciplinary team and have the responsibility to provide counseling to assigned caseload; with a strong emphasis on Mental Health and Initial Integrated Assessments. While providing individual, group and family therapy, participates in interdisciplinary treatment planning by developing a comprehensive psychosocial assessment and crisis intervention consultation. Complete necessary documentation. Provide public or educational presentations as needed.
